Meeting summary

The Open Video Seminar in Rio was a one-day event to explore policy around open standards, remixing, video distribution, intellectual property, free software, and net neutrality in Brasil. The purpose of the meeting was to identify the issues that will have far reaching consequences for internet video in Brasil—even ones that do not appear, at first blush, to relate to media democracy.

We're at critical point, at which national and international practice for video is still very malleable. Together, we can carve out space to ensure that online video is as open, democratic, and participatory as possible.

This gathering was part of a series of meetings focusing on the future of the online video medium, and the policies, practices, and software necessary to ensure that the medium is participatory and accessible. Earlier meetings have taken place at Yale University in New Haven, CT as well as the Center for Internet and Society in Bangalore, India. This summit was co-hosted by FGV's Center for Technology and Society, the Open Video Alliance, and iCommons.
